Dear Incoming Second-Fifth Grade Families,

First, a quick acknowledgement to Mr. Wilkey, our high school principal, for his recent podcast! Many of you may have heard him share that high school students won't be assigned summer reading; this decision fits their age and stage of development. Many are taking summer classes, working jobs, learning to drive, volunteering, or building other life skills. While they still need to read for classes and enjoyment, they've already developed strong reading comprehension and analytical skills. Elementary students, however, are still building those foundations. Regular reading over the summer helps strengthen vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension, and prevents the "summer slide," where progress gain over the school year can slip away during the summer break.

Below you will find the **REQUIRED** summer reading list for incoming second through fifth grade students. These books will be the basis for lessons, activities, discussions, and assignments starting on **the first day** of school in August. It's important that students complete the reading before August so they're ready to participate in class.

Label the books with your child's name and send them to school on the first day. **Students who don't complete the reading by the first day of school will struggle with assignments, which will affect their grades**.
